

FAWN LAKE

LOCATION:

Fawn Lake is located northeast from Plevna, a small town on Highway # 506.

SIZE / DEPTH:

Length - 3.3 kilometres

Width - 0.5 kilometres

Maximum Depth - 8.0 metres

Area - 1.55 kilometres squared

QUALITY:

In general the water quality in Fawn Lake is very good. The Provincial Water Quality Objective for Total Phosphorus is 20 micrograms per litre. The average calculated from the total phosphorus results for 2000 for the euphotic zone (penetration of light) and for the sample taken one metre off the bottom was 10.5, again indicating a moderately enriched or mesotrophic lake. Chlorophyll a is a measure of the algal density in the lake. The average chlorophyll a densities was 1.38 for Fawn Lake in 2000.

SURROUNDING LAND:

Records indicate that Fawn Lake is free from development but is affected by the activities on Big Gull Lake and Crotch Lake.

ACCESS:

Access onto Fawn Lake is available through the north and south ends of Crotch Lake.
